FREINDSHIP QUILT GUILD NAME TAG

Block is 6" Finished

Fabric A – 1 fat quarter of medium blue fabric

Fabric B − 1 fat quarter of medium gold fabric

Fabric C – 6 ½" square piece of fabric of your choice for backing

Batting 6 ½" square batting

Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block

Fabric A – Cut 4 - 2 ½" squares


Cut 2 - 2 7/8" squares; cut on diagonal once to make triangles

Fabric B - Cut 1 - 2 1/2" squares

Cut 2 - 27/8" squares; cut on diagonal once to make triangles

Sew one blue and gold half-square tringle together to make a square.

There will be four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press seams to darker side. Repeat 3 times to make a total of 4 blue and gold 2 $\frac{1}{3}$ " squares. Following the picture sew all 3 rows, using a scant $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam and pressing in alternating directions by row. This will make the front of your name tag.



Sew a layer of batting with the backing (Fabric C), and name tag (right sides together), leaving and opening for turning. Turn name tag right side out. Stitch/quilt as desired. Make with your own desired hanger.

Write, print, or embroider name in center square.
